RE: Pharmacy Dispensing Fee Increase

EFFECTIVE: November 1, 2021

Change to Dispensing Fee:

As noted in <u>Informational Letter (IL) 2095-MC-FFS</u>¹, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) requires submission of a state plan amendment (SPA) for a change to the pharmacy dispensing fee. Based on the 2020 Cost of Dispensing (COD) survey and approval from CMS, the dispensing fee will increase from \$10.07 to \$10.38 effective November 1, 2021.

The <u>2020 COD report</u>² is posted on the <u>lowa Medicaid Pharmacy Reimbursement Website</u>³ under COD Survey.

The dispensing fee is posted on the <u>DHS website</u>⁴ under the heading Pharmacy Dispensing Fee.
